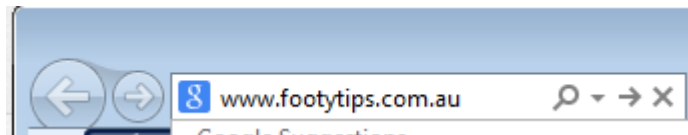


1 Goto footytips.com.au

4b Goto step 6

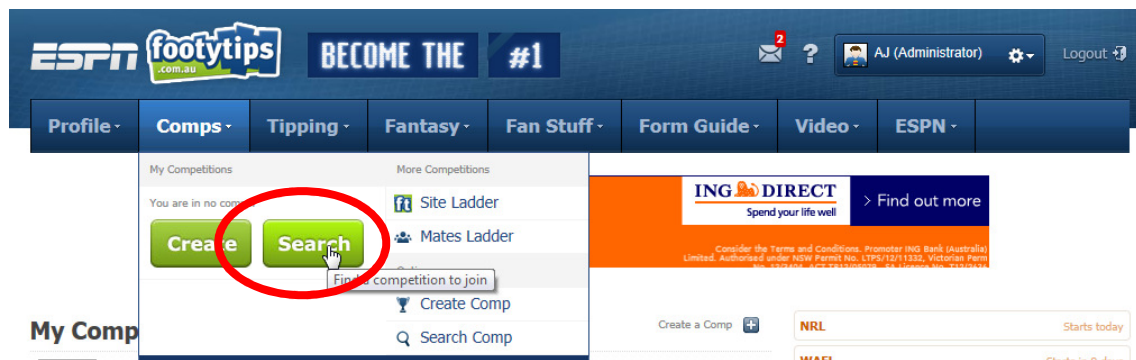
5 If you are new tipper click the **Join Now** button to join the competition.

6 After you login you will have to confirm all your details and agree to the terms and conditions.

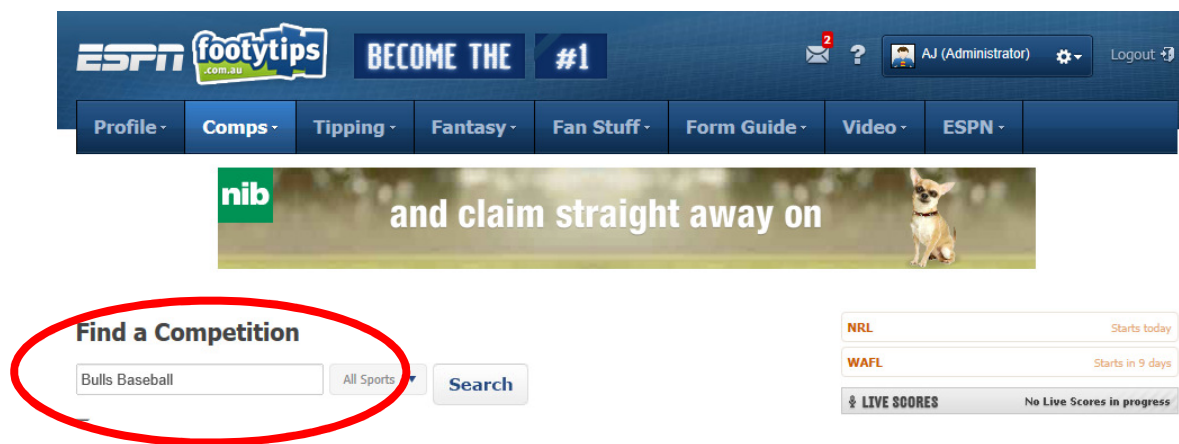
7 Click on the **Comps** button (red circle).



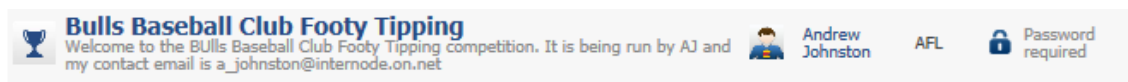
8 Click on **Search** (red circle)
